

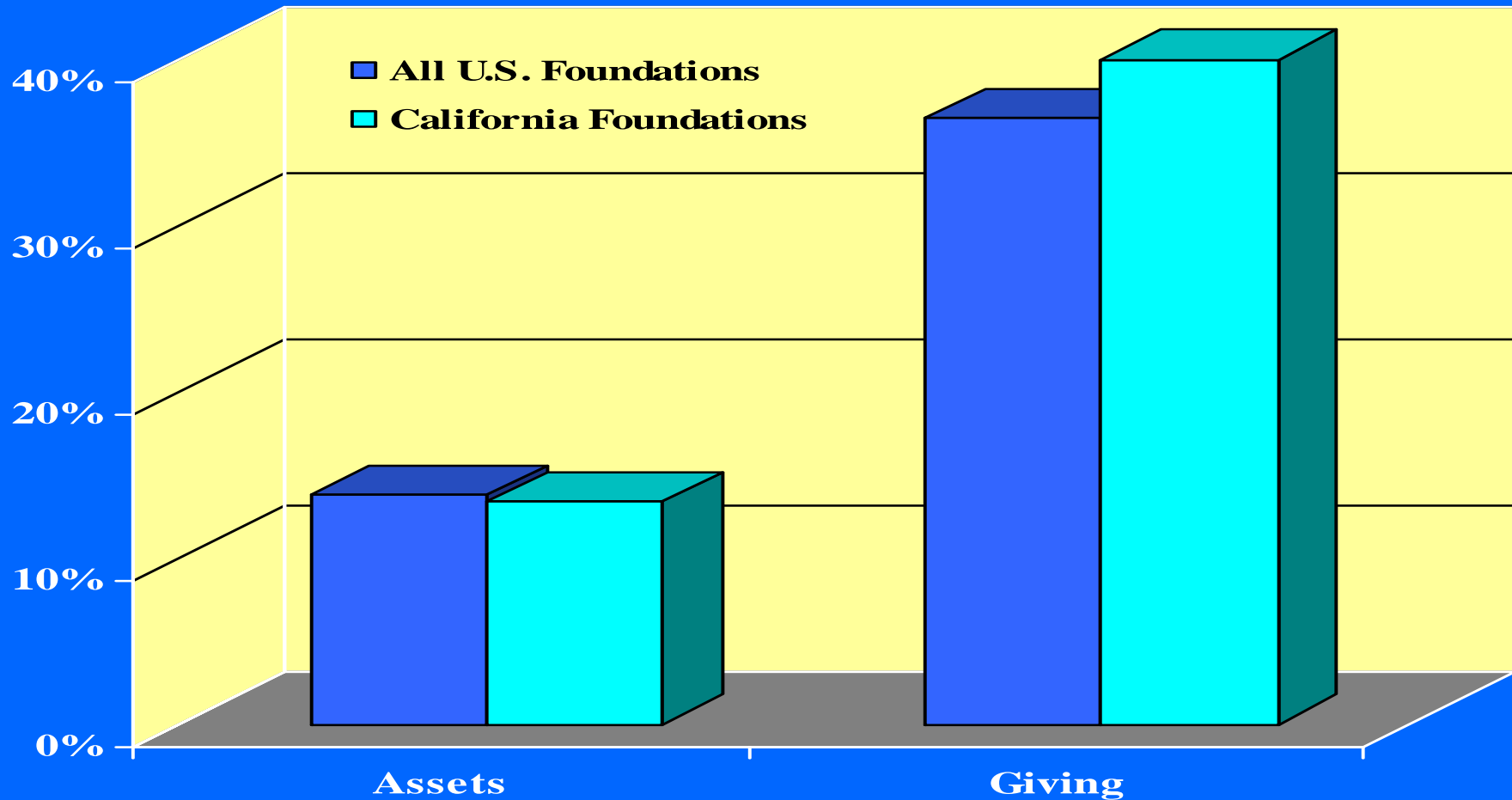

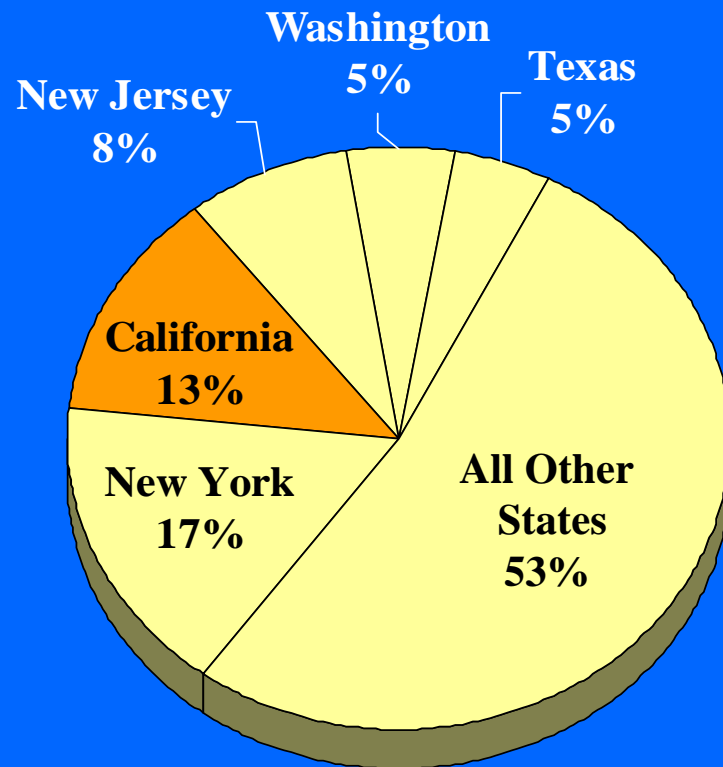
# Growth of All U.S. and California Foundations, 1999 to 2004\*



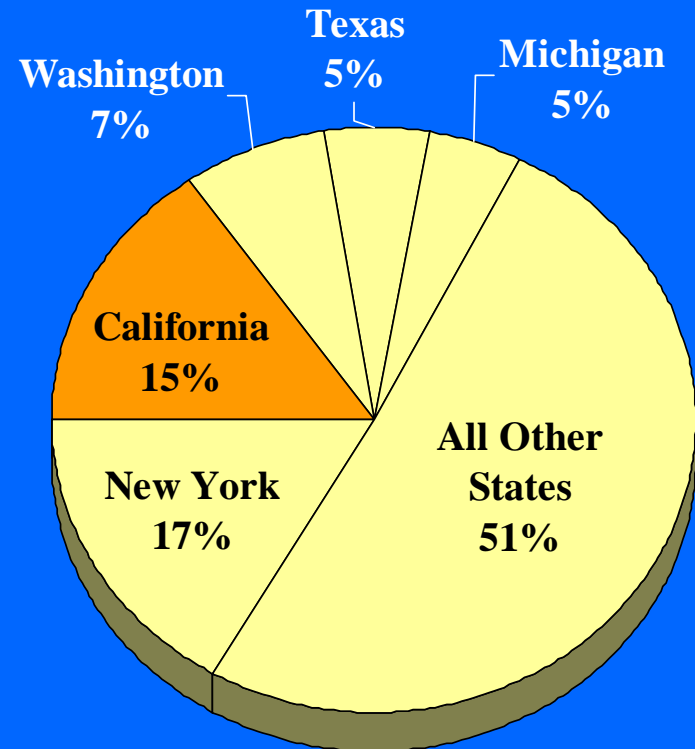

# Top Five States by Total Giving and Assets, 2004\*



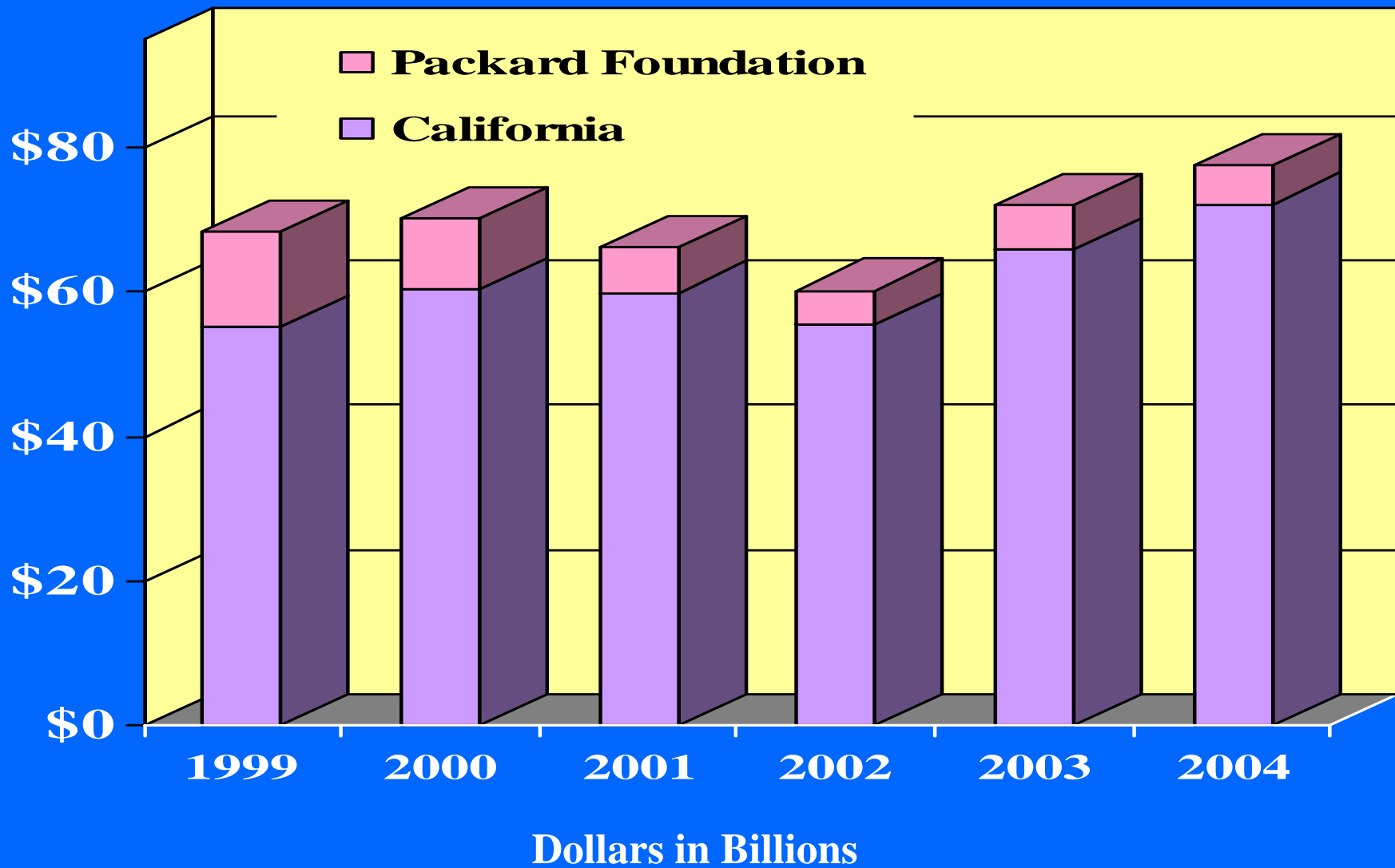
Total Giving = \$31.8 billion



Assets = \$510.5 billion

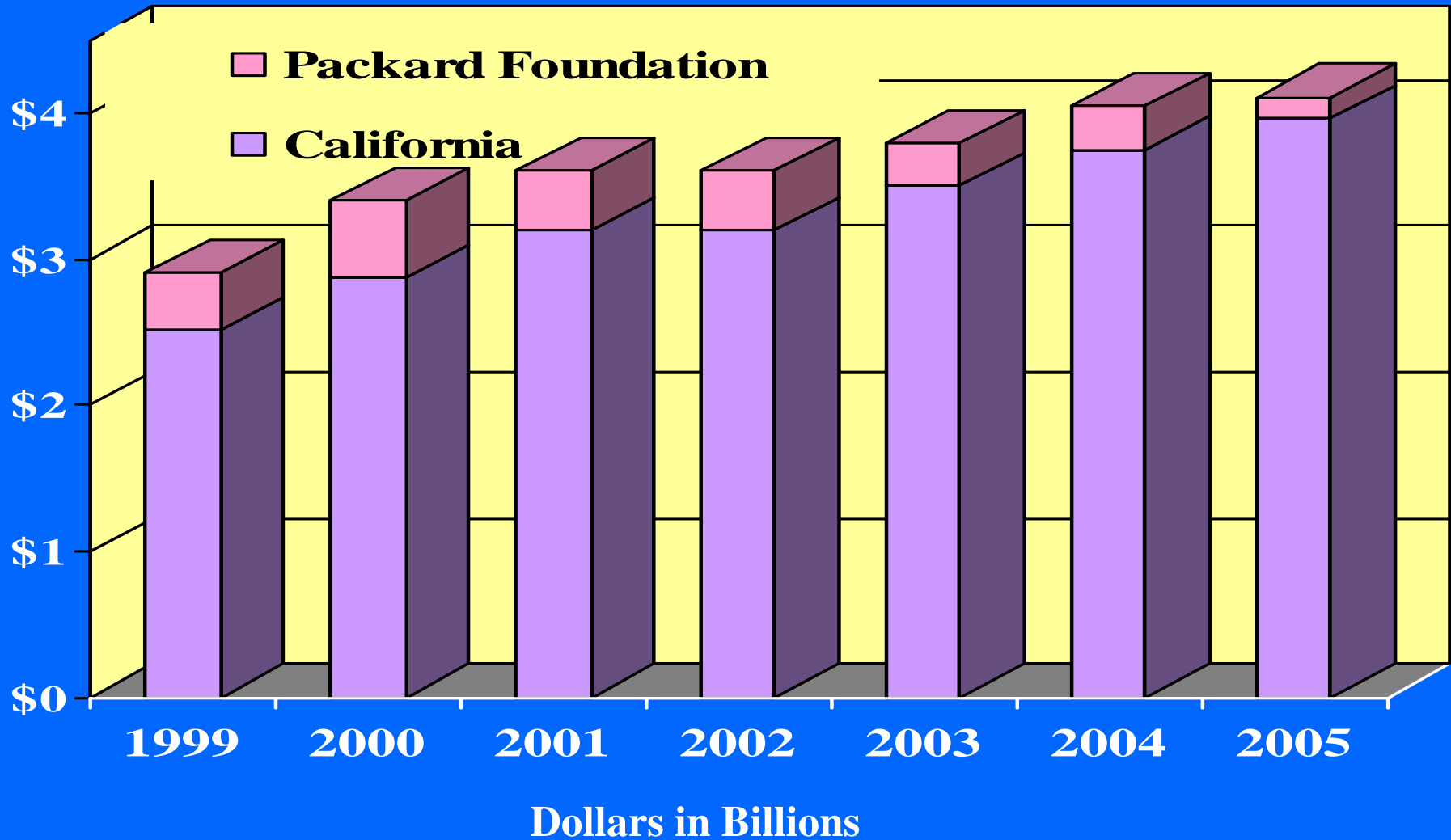

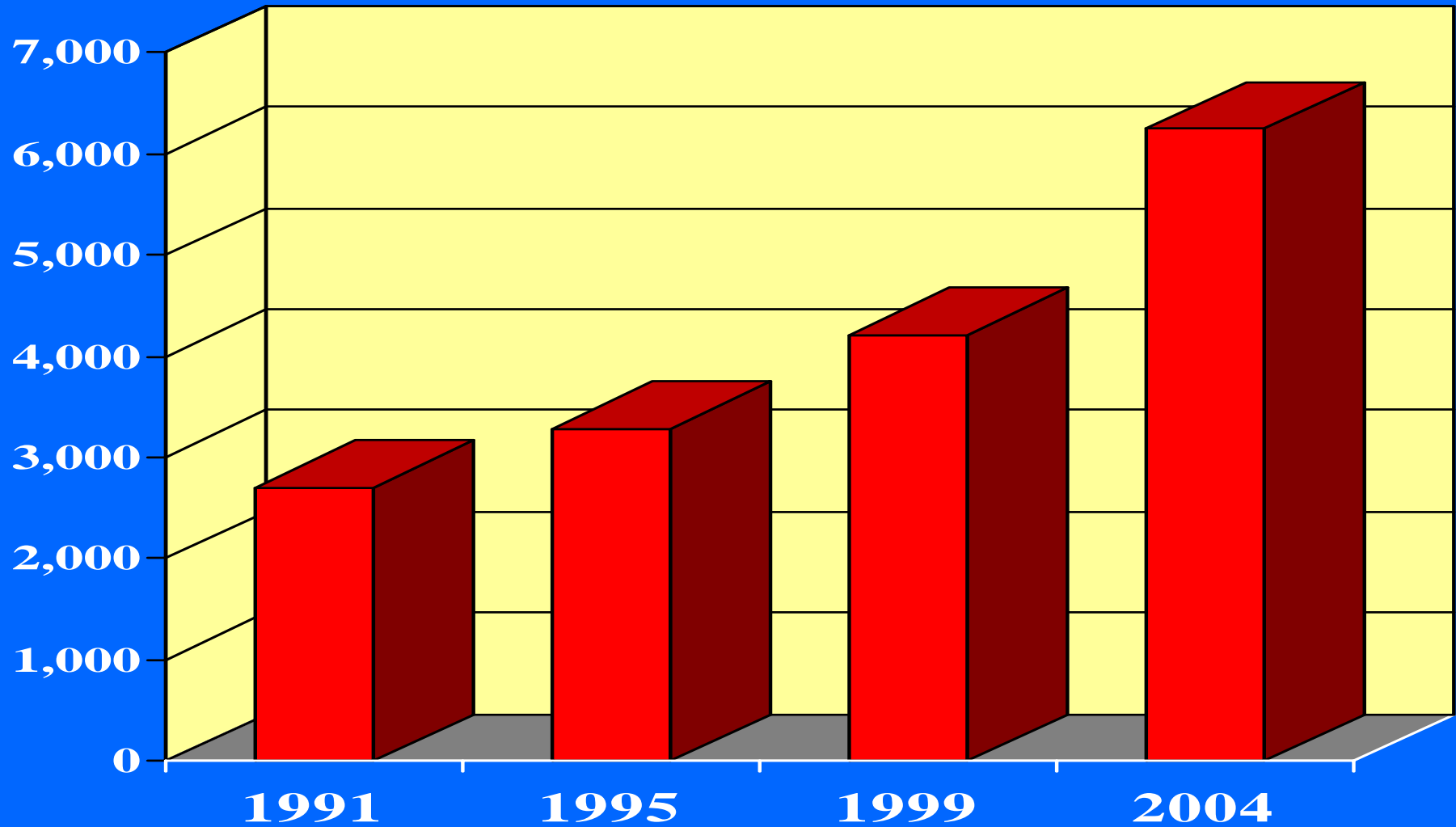
# Change in California Foundation Giving, 1999 to 2005

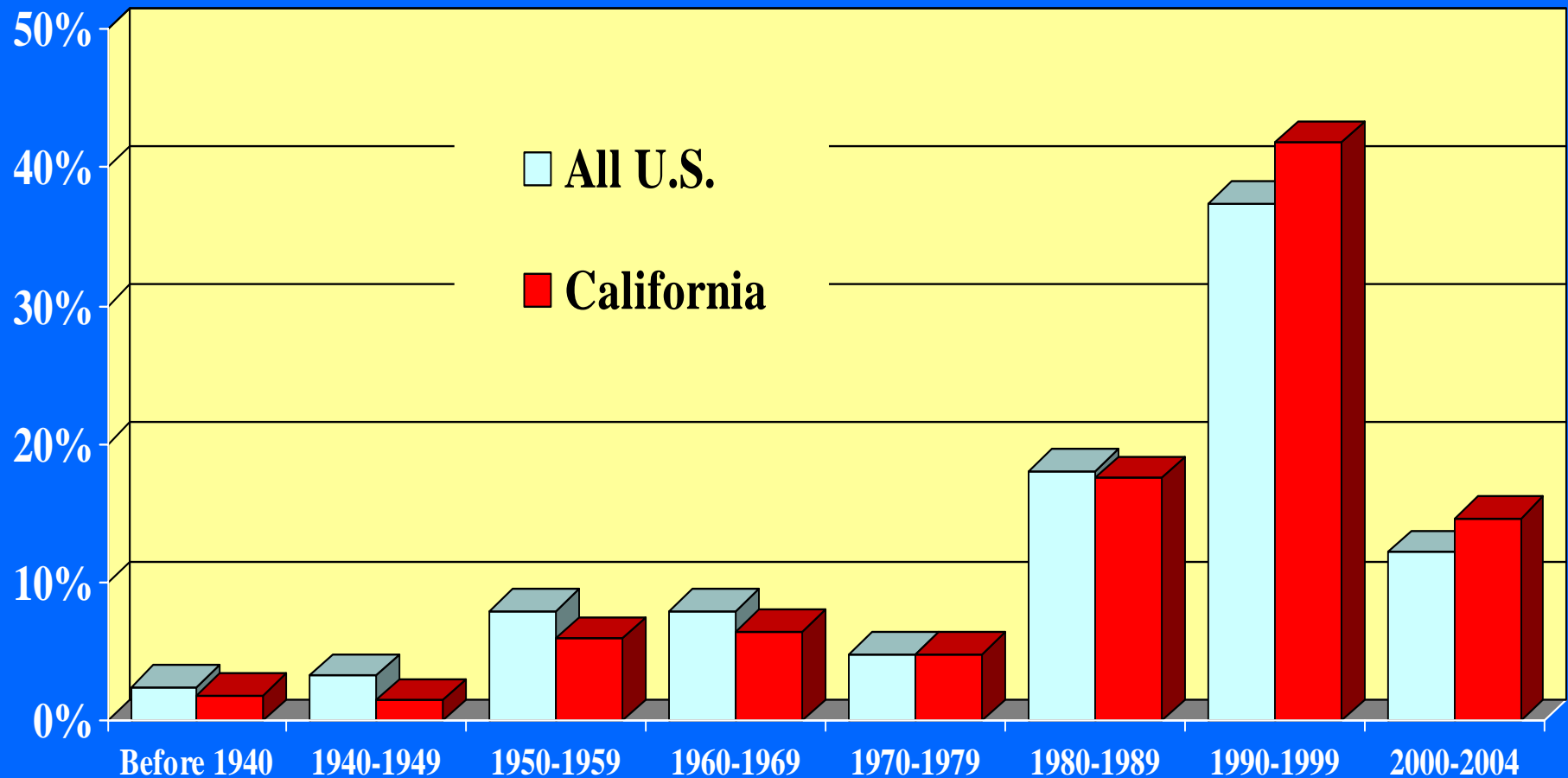

# Decade of Establishment for Larger U.S. and California Foundations\*



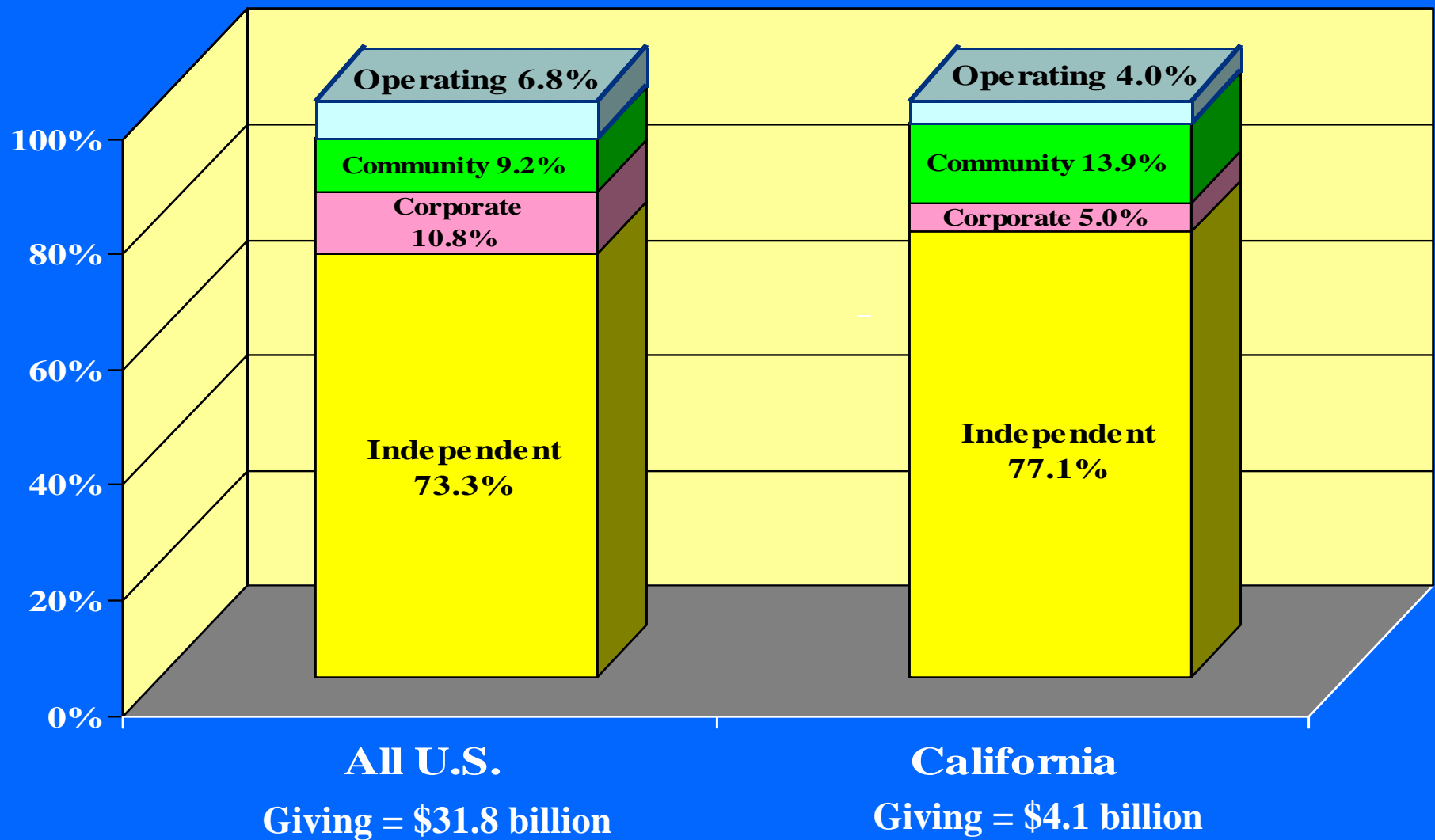

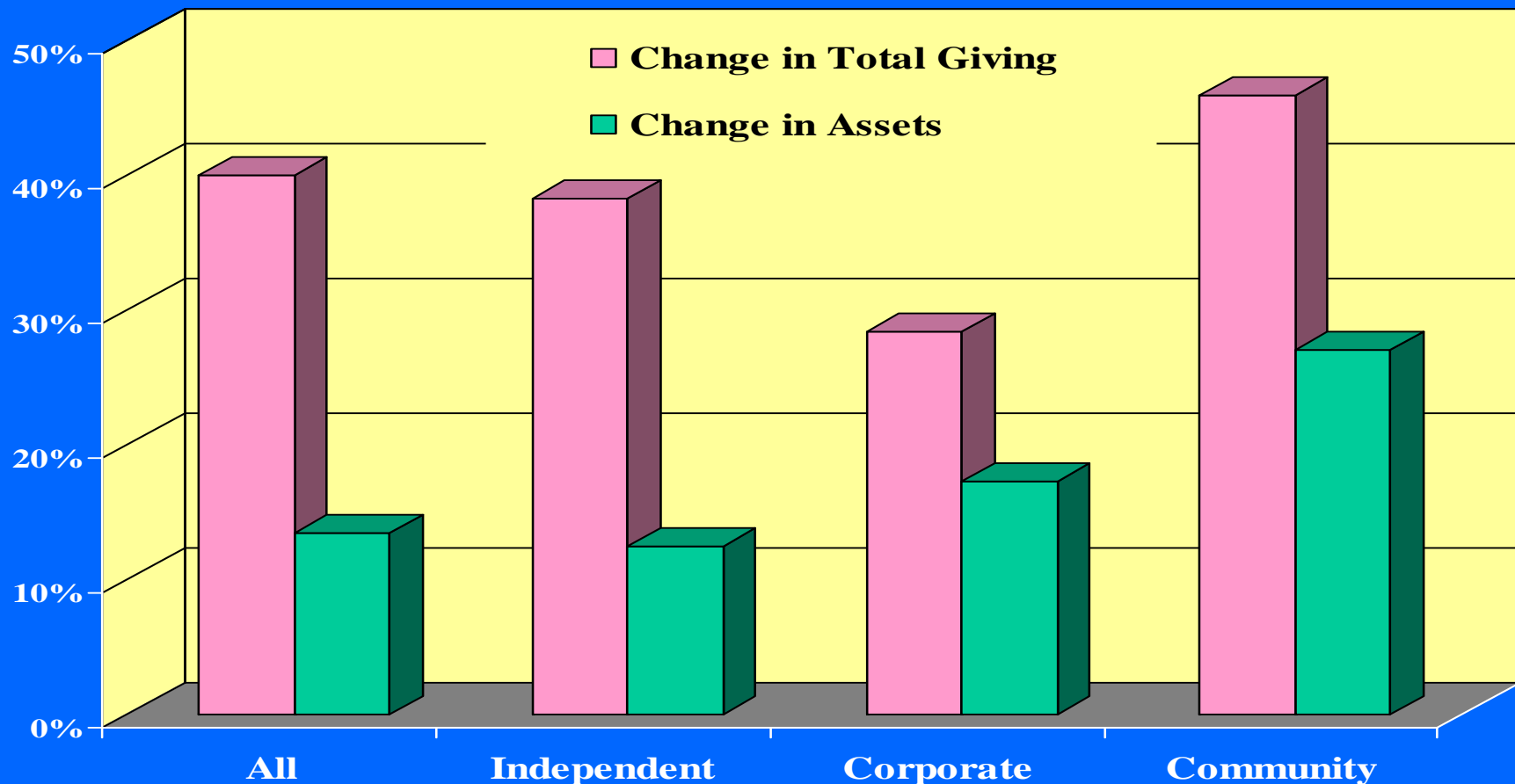

# Growth of California Foundations by Type, 1999 to 2004\*

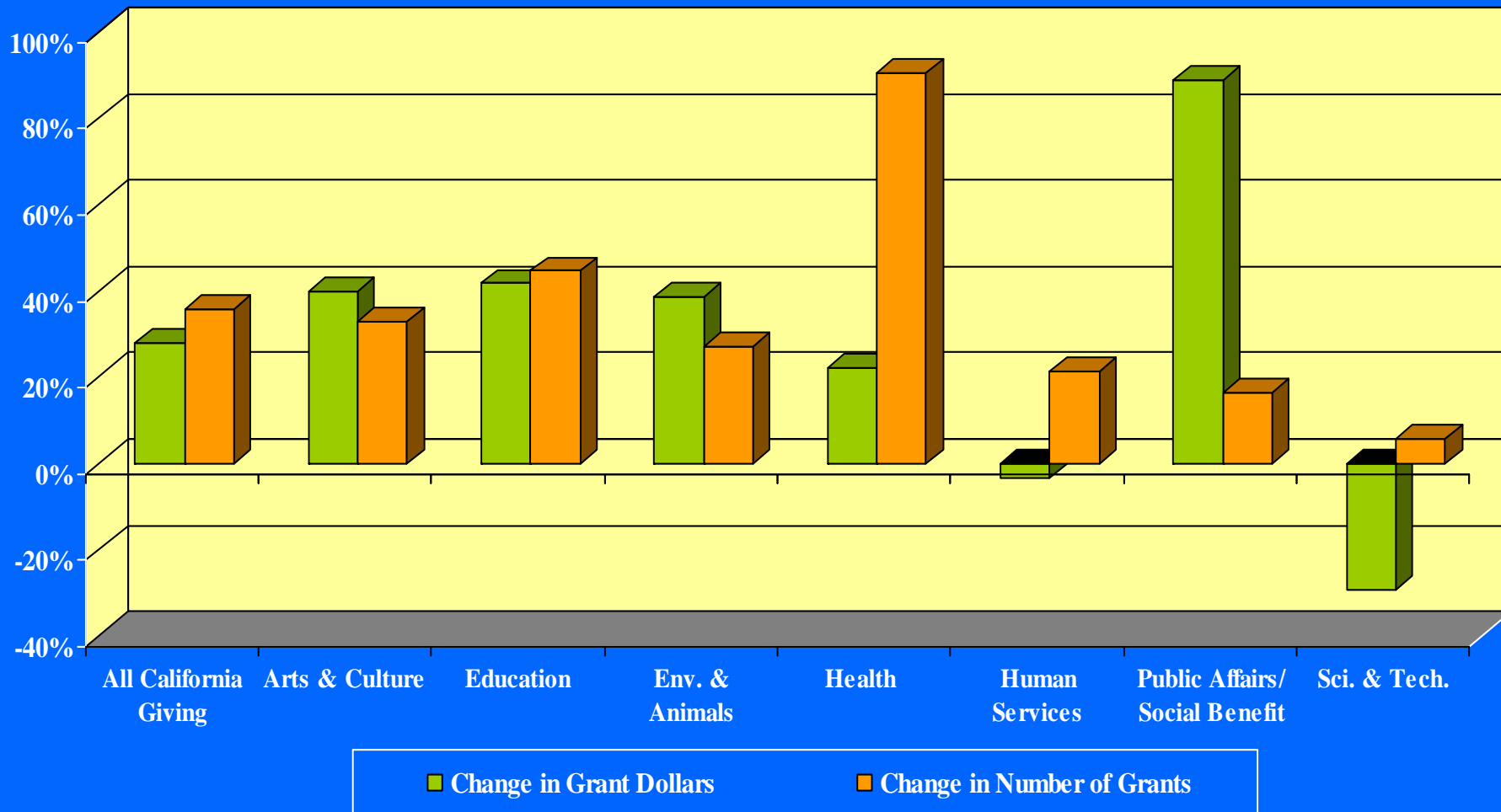

# Change in California Foundation Giving by Subject, 1999 to 2004

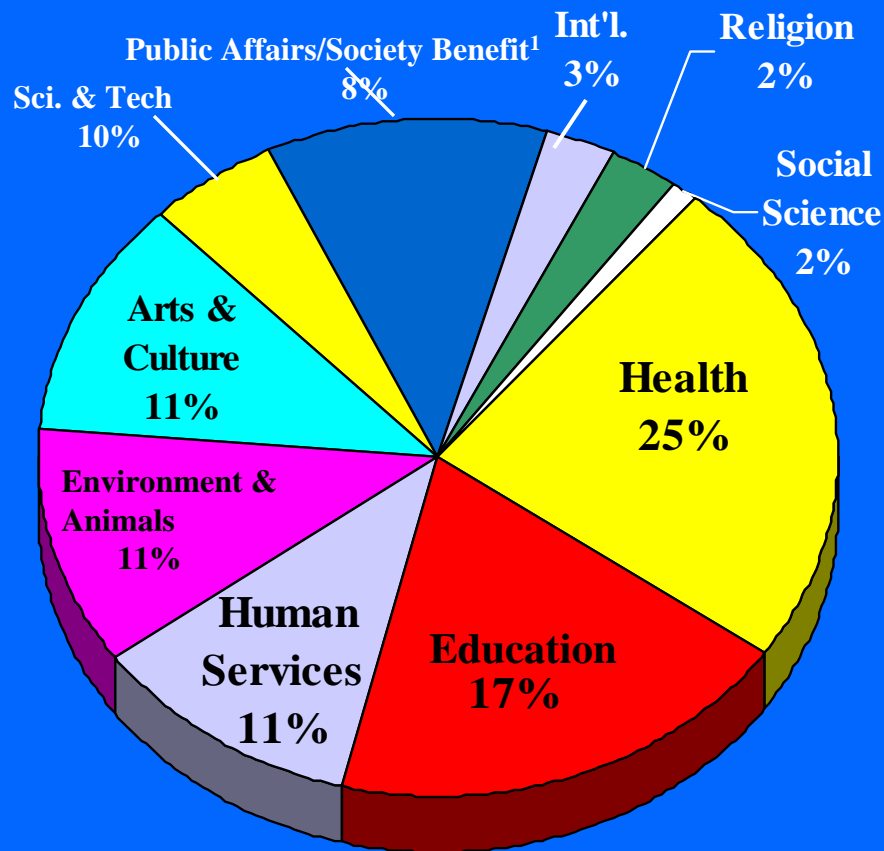

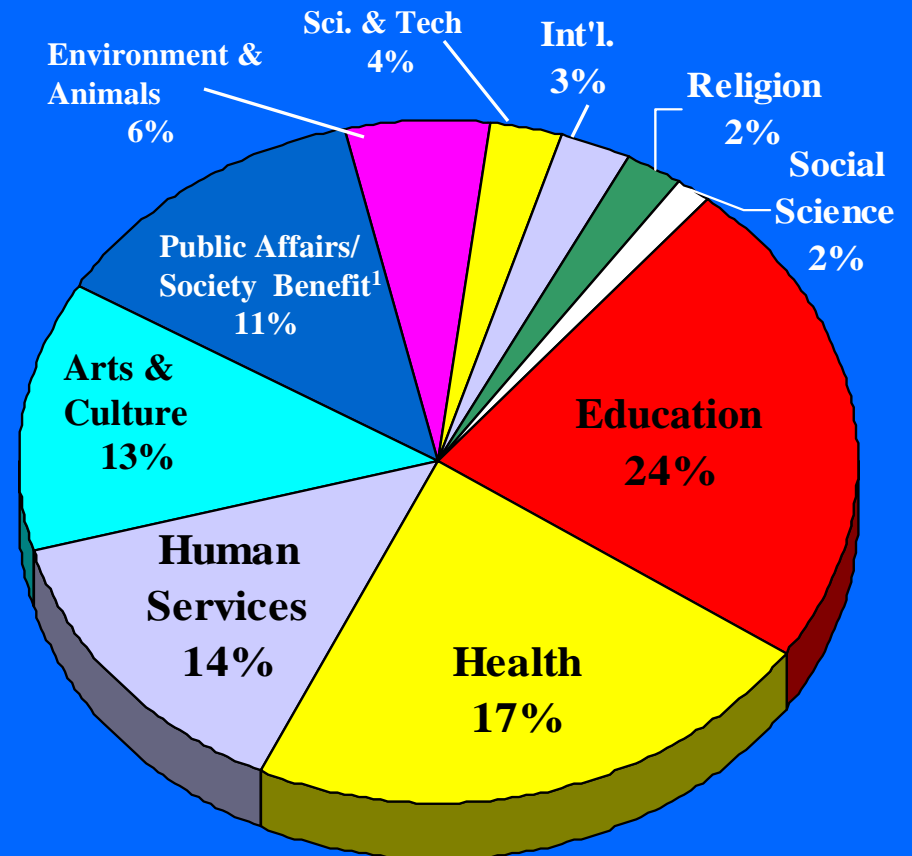

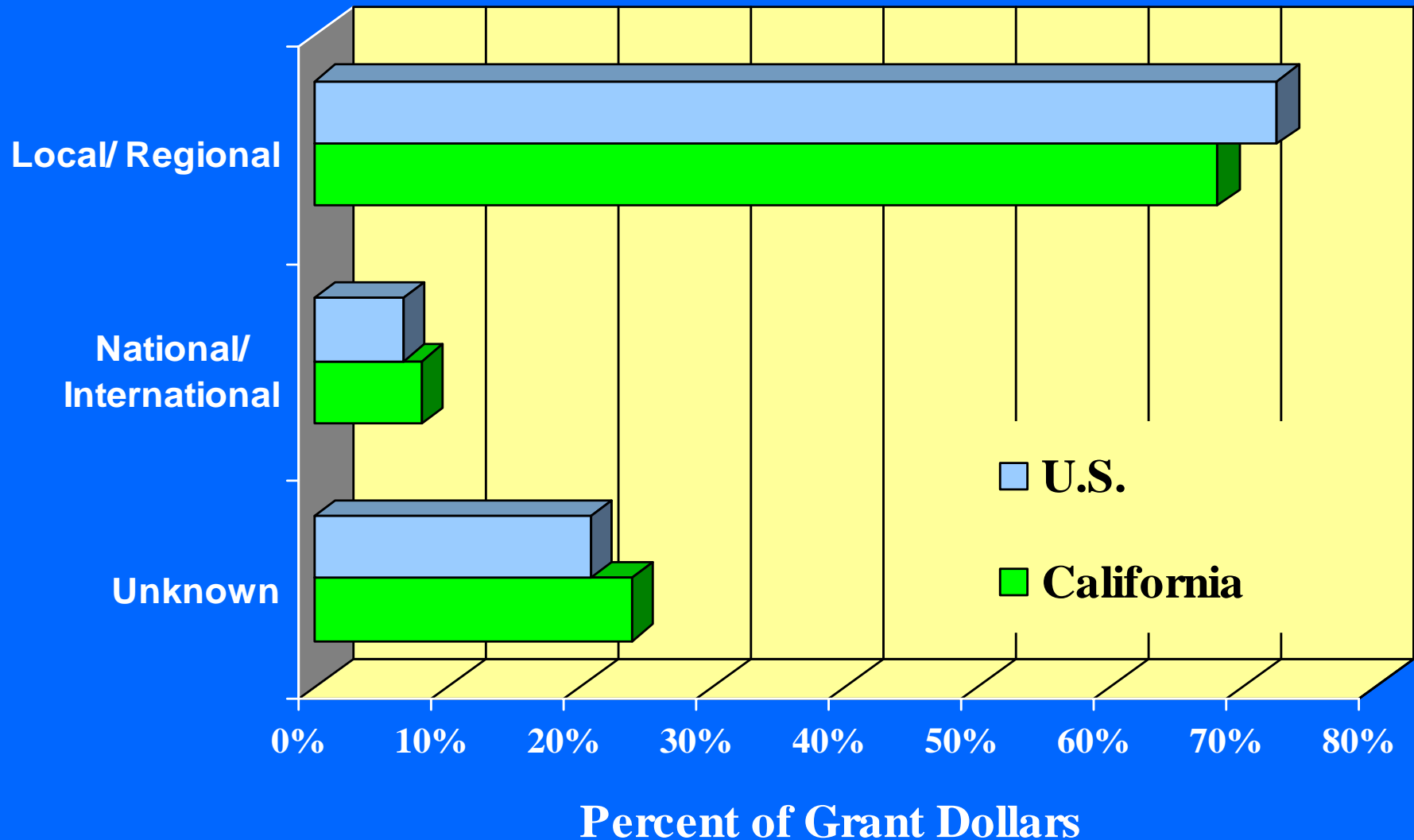

# Geographic Focus of California and All U.S. Foundations, 2004

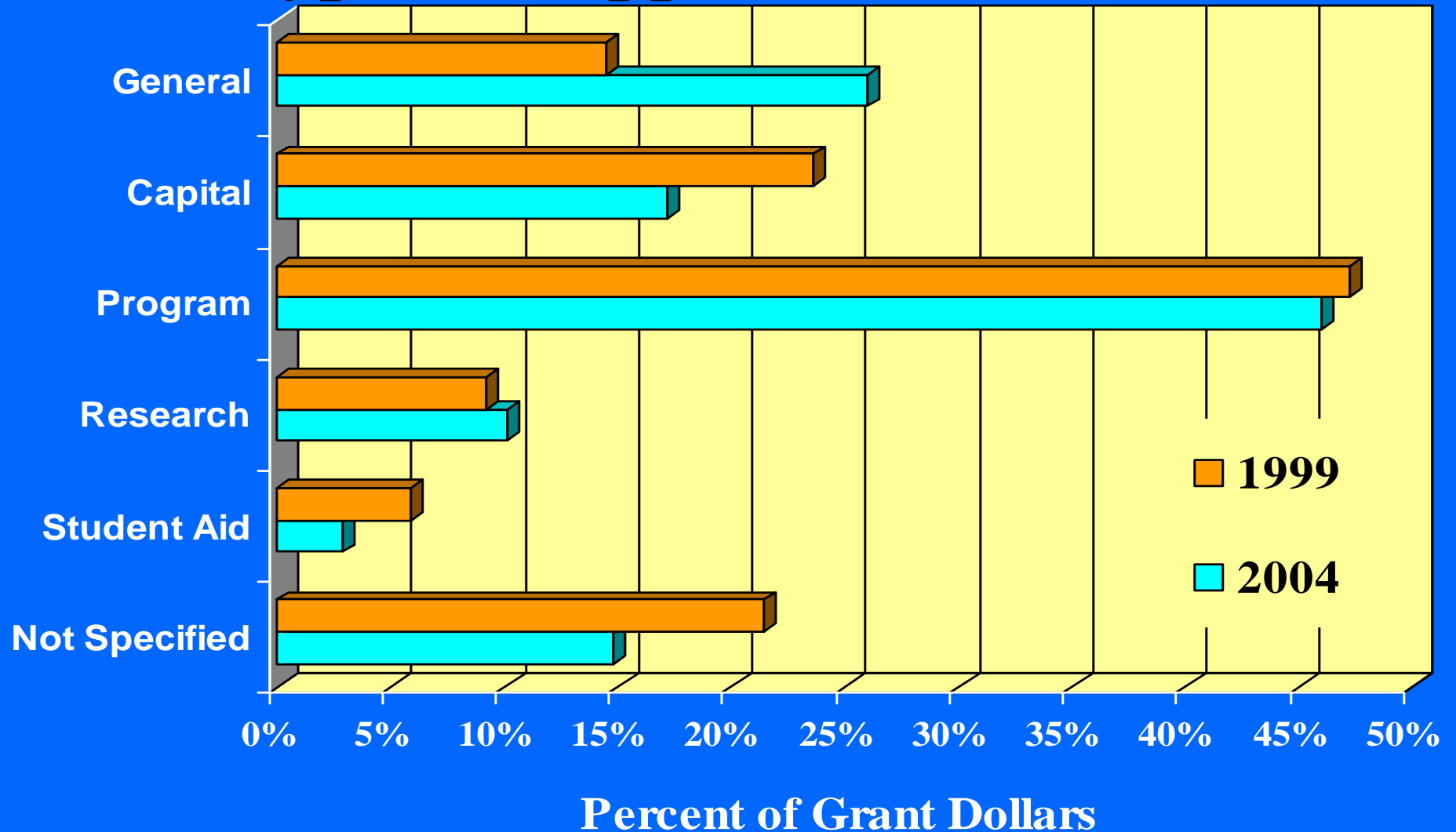

# California Foundation Giving by Types of Support, 1999 and 2004

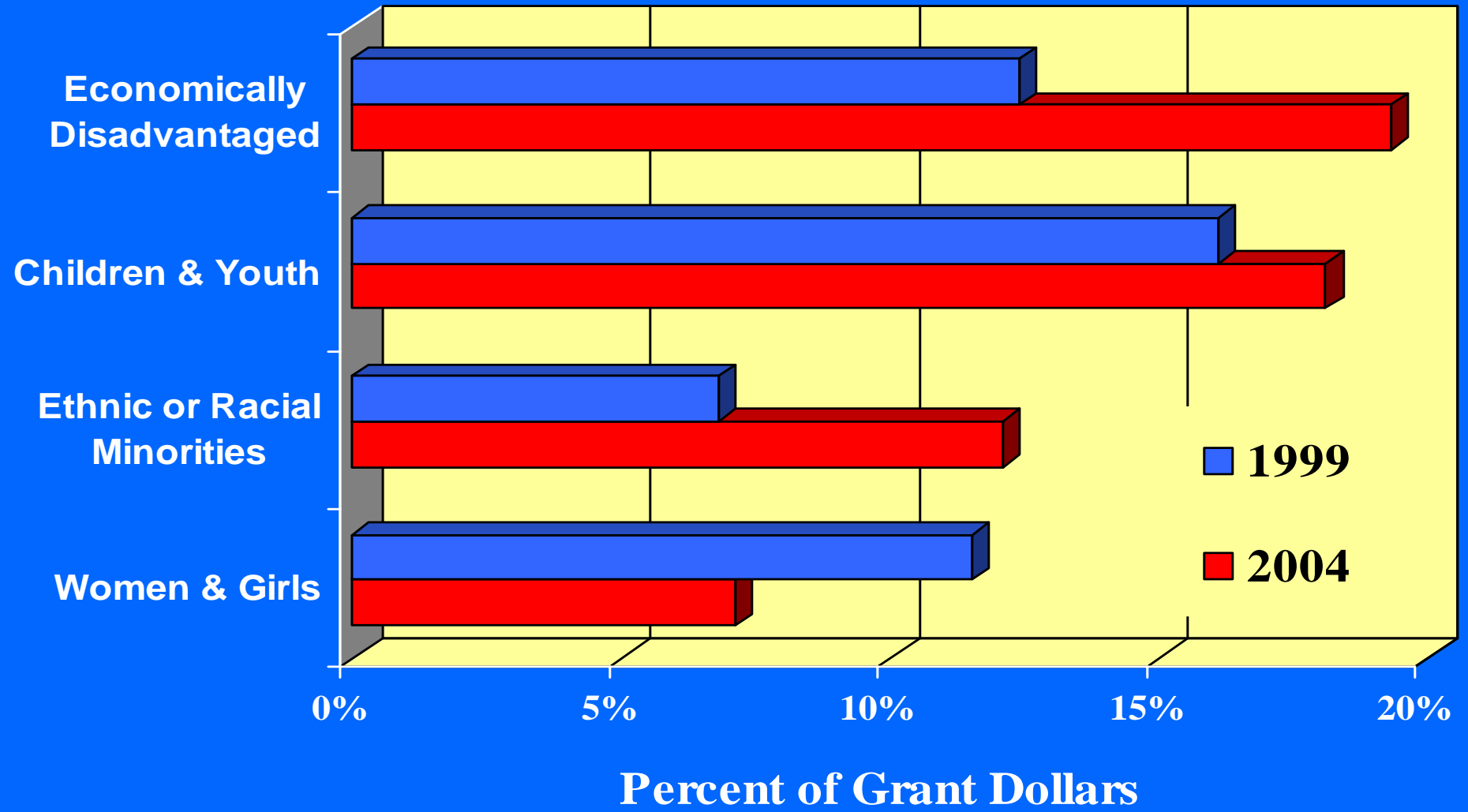
